6. The South aisle windows:

'The five principles of the Reformation which reflect all that is necessary for salvation' -



6.1 'By Scripture Alone' -

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.' *2 Timothy chapter 3 v 16*

The flowers point to the Bible which alone contains all that we believe and all that we need to know to be sure of eternal life.



6.2 **'By Faith Alone'** - 'Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.' *Romans chapter 5 v 1*

The window shows the Easter Garden where the tomb was found to be empty because Jesus had risen from the dead. A fact to be trusted.

6.3 'By Grace Alone' -

'It is by grace you have been saved.' *Ephesians chapter 2 v 5*

The basket represents the undeserved gift of salvation from God.



6.4 'Through Christ Alone' -

'Salvation is found in no-one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.' *Acts chapter 4 v 12*

The flowers point to the empty cross.



6.5 'Glory to God Alone' -

'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'

Matthew chapter 4 v 10

The flowers celebrate God's glory and goodness.

7. The Font: **'The River of Eternal Life'** - 'Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month.' *Revelation chapter 22 v 1*
